

BAITING A WILD PIG TRAP ROOT STICK TRIGGER

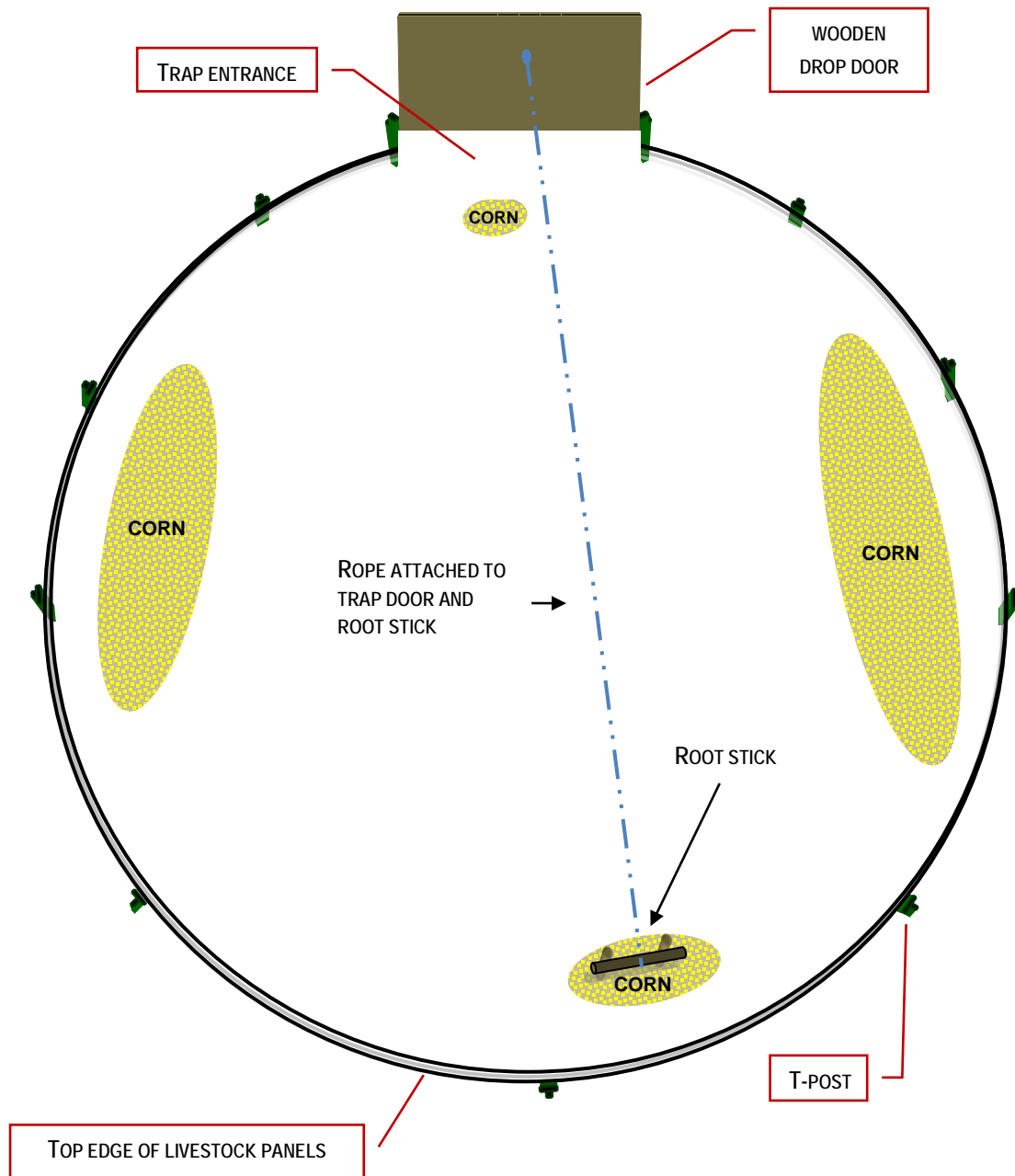

Figure 1: Bird's eye view of a corral trap demonstrating bait placement for trapping wild pigs. Place only a small amount of bait (corn) inside the door and only $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 gallon of corn around the trigger (root stick). A 5-gallon bucket of corn is sufficient for baiting a 3- to 5-panel trap.
